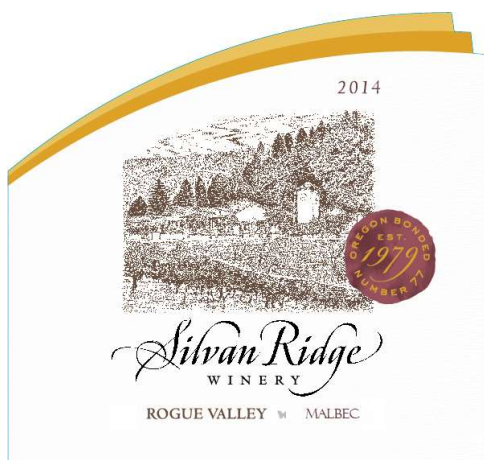




Tasting Notes

2014 ROGUE VALLEY MALBEC



Flavor Profile: Winemaker JP Valot, originally from Mendoza, calls this Malbec “an Oregon wine with an Argentine soul.” This wine’s intense, fruit-driven character displays aromas of plum, dark cherry and violet, with subtle hints of earth and spice on the palate. The mouthfeel is generous in this full-bodied wine, with a very long finish.
