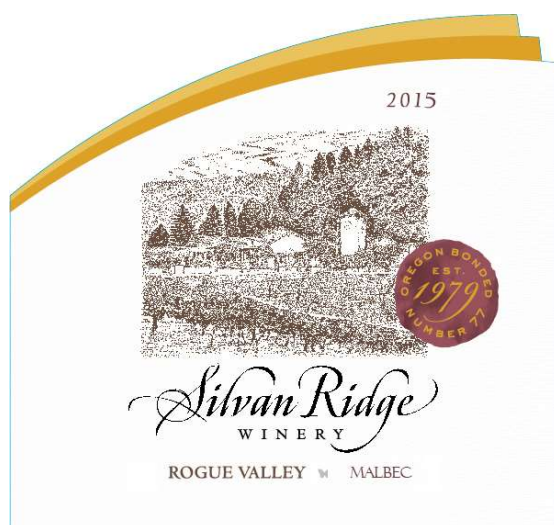




Tasting Notes

2015 ROGUE VALLEY MALBEC



Flavor Profile: Winemaker JP Valot, originally from Mendoza, calls this Malbec “an Oregon wine with an Argentine soul.” When asked about our new release he adds, “Of all the wines we make, Malbec is the most challenging. But it’s constantly evolving and improving. I think we’re on the right path.” This vintage offers a lush nose laced with boysenberry and cocoa. Soft yet concentrated on the palate, with additional flavors of black cherry, vanilla, and cardamom.
